

RESOLUTION OF THE MANITOBA METIS FEDERATION CABINET
To Amend the MMF Local By-Law with Respect to the Definition of an
Active Local

WHEREAS the MMF established a committee to review the MMF Constitution, Local By-Law and Election By-Law under the direction of the Ministers responsible for the Constitution, Natural Resources & Citizenship, and Justice;

AND WHEREAS the committee also involved staff, legal counsel, and the MMF Chief Electoral Officer;

AND WHEREAS the MMF Cabinet has received recommendations from the committee with respect to the appropriate amendments to the MMF Constitution, Local By-Law and Election By-Law;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE MANITOBA METIS FEDERATION CABINET ADOPTS AND APPROVES THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE MMF LOCAL BY-LAW WHICH SHALL BE PRESENTED AT THE NEXT ANNUAL GENERAL ASSEMBLY:

Article VIII be added to the MMF Local By-Law which states:

ARTICLE VIII

1. Active Local

An "Active Local" shall mean a Local that has, for three (3) consecutive years, met the following criteria:

- (a) provided notice of the dates and times of its meetings to members in a manner prescribed by the Cabinet of the MMF by resolution or enactment;

- (b) provided its minutes of meetings to the corresponding Regional Office and the MMF Home Office on a regular basis, and in any event, within three (3) months of any meeting;
- (c) had at least one (1) member attend the Regional meetings of the MMF to which the Local belongs; and
- (d) had at least one (1) member attend the AGA of the MMF.
