

RESOLUTION OF THE MANITOBA METIS FEDERATION CABINET

To Amend the MMF Election By-Law with Respect to the Definition of the Deputy Returning Officer

WHEREAS the MMF established a committee to review the MMF Constitution, Local By-Law and Election By-Law under the direction of the Ministers responsible for the Constitution, Natural Resources & Citizenship, and Justice;

AND WHEREAS the committee also involved staff, legal counsel, and the MMF Chief Electoral Officer;

AND WHEREAS the MMF Cabinet has received recommendations from the committee with respect to the appropriate amendments to the MMF Constitution, Local By-Law and Election By-Law;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE MANITOBA METIS FEDERATION CABINET ADOPTS AND APPROVES THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE MMF ELECTION BY-LAW WHICH SHALL BE PRESENTED AT THE NEXT ANNUAL GENERAL ASSEMBLY:

Article II 4. of the MMF Election By-Law which states:

4. "Deputy Returning Officer" – means a person appointed by the Chief Electoral Officer to manage and conduct voting procedures at polls that are established by the Chief Electoral Officer.

Is hereby deleted and the following is therefore substituted:

4. "Deputy Returning Officer" – means a person appointed by the Chief Electoral Officer to:

(a) manage and conduct voting procedures at a poll or polls that are established by the Chief Electoral Officer; and

(b) provide such further and other support as may be required by the Chief Electoral Officer for that poll including, without restricting the generality of the foregoing, the placement of advertisements, materials, posters, or other like items as directed by the Chief Electoral Officer to inform the Citizens of the election and its details.
